77% Agree: Staff are responsive and able to assist me when needed

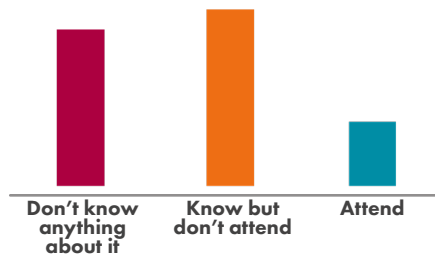
