- 2) The unit pricing provided will be incorporated into the contract.
- 3) Pricing will be evaluated using a weighted scale method based on estimated usage percentages for each line item. The estimated percentages represent the anticipated frequency of use for each service category over the term of the contract. Each bidder's unit prices will be multiplied by these usage weights to determine a total weighted cost, which will be used for price comparison purposes. The weighted cost calculation is for evaluation only and does not guarantee any specific quantities or dollar value of work. The weights will also be applied equally to all bidders. The resulting total will identify the lowest overall cost vendor based on the expected mix of services during the contract term
- 4) Contract award will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible Offeror.
- 5) In submitting this bid, it is understood that the right is reserved by CIHA to reject any and all bids at its sole discretion and for its convenience or benefit. The bidder agrees to execute and deliver to CIHA a contract in the prescribed form and furnish the required performance and payment bonds within ten (10) days of contract execution.
- 6) Bid cannot be withdrawn for a period of thirty (30) days without the express permission of CIHA.
